

Membership Form

To be admitted as a member, you must:

- a) be consistent with the mission and objectives of Projets Autochtones du Québec;
- b) sign a membership form submitted by the organization;
- c) be accepted as such by the board of directors.

Members receive notices of meetings of members of the organization, have the right to attend these meetings, have the right to speak and to vote. They are eligible as members of the board of directors of the organization, subject to section 29.1 [of the General By-laws].

Mission

The mission of Projets Autochtones du Québec is to provide shelter and social integration services adapted to First Nations, Inuit and Metis cultures living in precarious situations or in transition.

The main objectives of the organization are:

- a) provide Aboriginal shelter and emergency food and social services to alleviate poverty through charitable giving;
- b) identify the needs and risk factors of the urban Aboriginal community in terms of physical health and well-being;
- c) provide culturally appropriate programs and reintegration services for the benefit of the community;
- d) rent residential units for persons from the Aboriginal community with low or modest incomes.
